## **Monday**

Ask the Lord to reveal himself afresh to your pastor as:

- the Fountain of Wisdom that your pastor may be granted insight into difficult situations; (Proverbs 18:3)
- the Master Potter that your pastor would be molded into the image of Christ (Isaiah 64:8)
- the Rock and Fortress in whom your pastor would find refuge (II Samuel 22:2)
- the Prince of Peace that your pastor would find rest for his soul in Jesus alone.

## **Tuesday**

Ask the Lord to give your pastor a humble heart, a teachable spirit and a servant's heart (Exodus 33:13; Proverbs 3:34; I Peter 5:5–6)

Pray that your pastor would be granted the ability to be used of the Lord to bring hope to the brokenhearted, lift up the downcast, care for the less fortunate and bring the light of the Gospel into the lives of those who are surrounded by despair (Isaiah 61:1; II Corinthians 4:8, 7:6).

## **Wednesday**

Pray that your pastor would have a heart after God's own heart (Acts 13:22; I Samuel 3:9; Isaiah 1:19–20). Entreat God to grant your pastor a soft, obedient and listening heart. Pray that your pastor would drink deeply from the well spring of God's grace.

Ask the Sovereign King to grant your pastor a daily, fresh and renewed desire to know Christ and the power of His glorious resurrection (I Corinthians 2:2; Philippians 3:8–11). Pray that your pastor would commit to place their focus on the Supremacy of Christ and be wholly and solely dependent upon Him! Pray that your pastor would be a willing recipient of God's daily grace (John 15:5).

### **Thursday**

Ask the Lord to reveal himself afresh to your pastor as the Almighty Sovereign that your pastor may be granted strength (Exodus 15:2). Pray that the Light of the World would break forth into darkness and guide your pastor on the journey of life (Psalm 31:3; John 9:5).

Pray that the Holy Spirit would empower your pastor to have the courage to say and do what God wants done (Acts 4:31; Eph. 6:19–20; I Peter 4:10–11)

### **Friday**

Ask the Lord to grant your pastor wisdom and guidance as they lead, teach and counsel (Jeremiah 33:3; Proverbs 3:5–6; Jeremiah 10:21; Isaiah 58:11; James 1:5). Pray that God would grant them a clear vision for the church (Proverbs 19:18; Jeremiah 10:21).

Pray for your pastor to have special divine insight into God's Word (John 16:13) and the ability to clearly communicate God's Word (I Peter 4:10–11)

### **Saturday**

Ask the Lord to Guard your pastor's heart from competition, unhealthy ambitions, futile thinking and vain imagination. Ask that every thought be taken captive to obey Christ. Ask that your pastor would fear God and not people and Godly boldness to confront sin. May the agenda of the church be set by the Holy Spirit and not by antagonists (Deuteronomy 8:6; Job 2:3; II Corinthians 10:5).

Implore the Lord to make your pastor a channel of His love and grace as they lead your church (II Thessalonians 2:16). Ask that the Lord might grant them Christian character and integrity in all of their relationships and dealings in life and that your pastor would be used of the Lord as an instrument of forgiveness and reconciliation (Titus 2:7; Acts 9:15; II Corinthians 5:18–19).

### **Sunday**

Pray that the Heavenly Father would use your pastor as a mouthpiece of the Gospel (I Corinthians 9:16). As they preach, pray that your pastor would proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord in the energy and strength of the Holy Spirit (Mark 13:11). Pray that the Word of God never be compromised, cheapened or dumbed down; rather, that through your pastor, it may it be delivered in confidence with power, conviction, clarity and boldness, with love and in truth (Acts 9:28; II Timothy 4:1–2).
